

## **REVIEW OF SAFE AND SECURE TASK GROUP**

"The 'Safe and Secure' task group has not met since last year and during this time there has been extensive consultation across the Borough on the new Crime, Disorder, and Drugs Reduction Strategy which is now available on the web site.. The task group will be invited to participate in reviewing the progress against the strategy and monitoring the activities of the local crime and disorder partnership; now known as 'The Safer Runnymede Partnership'. They will also be able to raise concerns if members of the group become aware that there are changing issues during the life of the strategy."

The task group does not have its' own targets. It reviews those in the crime, Disorder and Drugs Reduction Strategy.

### **Targets on which real progress can be made in the next 12-18 months:**

1. Developing solutions to deal with individuals or identified areas to reduce anti-social behaviour.
2. To increase the reporting of, and reduce the repetition of domestic violence incidents.
3. To increase the number of arrests for drug offences.

### **Other targets:**

1. To reduce crime in the Borough by 11% by 2007-2008.
2. To reduce the number of residential burglaries
2. To reduce the supply of alcohol to people under age
3. To improve the quality of life and feelings of reassurance
4. To reduce number of racially aggravated crimes
5. To reduce road casualties and excessive speeding
6. To reduce number of vehicle crime offences

### **Membership:**

Group has started to consider who should attend as members but as yet has not performed any work itself but rather reviews the CDRP activities and results. It is keen to increase representation from the community and the voluntary sector.

### **Underlap/Overlap:**

Little over or underlap with other groups except that young people issues can crop in others but safe & secure is tightly defined as crime and disorder, not general youth work.
