1. **Page 1** **53 Hare Hill, Addlestone – RU.09/0891**
- Consultations:**
- Paragraph 4.1  
A further 3 letters of objection have been received reiterating the concerns set out in the report.
- Paragraph 4.4  
The Council's Amenities Officer does not consider that the loss of poor quality trees is significant on this site.
- Paragraph 4.6  
The Surrey Wildlife Trust recommends that further survey work should be carried out in regard to the presence of roosting bats, badgers and reptiles.
- Planning Considerations:**
- Paragraph 5.6:  
The first line of paragraph 5.6 should read:
- 'Block 1 would be clearly visible from No. 51 Hare Hill and Nos. 7 and 9 The Ridings...'
- Paragraph 5.12:  
In the eighth line of paragraph 5.12 'traffic' should replace 'highway' to read 'raise no objection on highway safety or traffic generation grounds'.

- Amendments or additions in bold type represent the two additional letters received.
- 4.1 The application has been advertised in the Council's weekly list and letters have been sent to neighbouring properties. **Twelve** letters have been received, **4** of which support the application and **8** raise objections to the proposal. (It is noted that of the **8** objection letters received, 3 were from the same household.)
