Council Tax – Youth Training Trainees

Set out below is the criteria that must be met in order that a person may qualify for this discount.

A person who is aged under 25 and who is undertaking training through arrangements made under the Employment and Training Act 1973, is a youth training trainee provided that any training undertaken is funded by the Learning and Skills Council for England.

The definition of Youth Training Trainees (YTTs) also includes Youth Credit Trainees (YCCs). Youth Credits are a part of Youth Training, as are a number of other schemes in operation which do not go under the name 'Youth Training' but still fall within the definition of YT. The discount disregard applies to people on any of these schemes, such as Options, Future and Next Step, which are examples of the different names for TY and YC schemes.

If you are able to fulfill the above criteria please confirm your situation in writing, also stating the number of adults residing in the property (aged 18 years and over) including yourself. Please send the information to the Council Tax section at the address shown below.
