Scheme.

Under this Scheme, County Sportspeople who live in the Borough of Runnymede may be eligible to train free of charge, at the Council's leisure facilities, during off-peak hours.

Such facilities include not only Abbeylands and Egham Sports Centre, but also the many bowling greens and tennis courts located throughout the Borough, as detailed on the reverse of this leaflet.

Applying for a **F.A.C.S** card couldn't be easier, simply read through the conditions to determine whether you are eligible, then complete and return the application form attached.

**The CONDITIONS of the Scheme are as follows:-**

**F.A.C.S scheme users:**

-  Must be of County Standard or above in their sport and provide a supporting letter from an official of their Governing Body.
-  Must be a resident of Runnymede.
-  Must produce a valid F.A.C.S card on every visit to a facility.
-  Will be restricted to the use of facilities that complement the sport they represent. These facilities will be listed with their membership details.
-  Can only use facilities if they are available and if such use does not prevent the use by a paying customer.
-  Cannot book free use of facilities in advance.

**Conditions regarding Leisure Centres:**

-  Free usage is restricted to:-  
Abbeylands Sports Centre - 9 a.m. - 6 p.m.,  
 Monday - Friday & all day Saturday & Sunday.  
ESC Leisure - 6.30 a.m. - 3.30 p.m. and  
 9 p.m. - 10.30 p.m. Monday - Friday,  
 8 a.m. - 6 p.m. Saturday, 8 a.m. - 10 p.m. Sunday.  
 All other facilities at all open hours i.e. Aerobics has concession prices all day.
-  Scheme users must pay the full fees for any use of these facilities outside of the hours listed above.
-  If the fitness suite at these facilities is to be used then scheme users must complete and pay for an induction.
-  If the scheme user is under 16, they can only use the fitness suite if accompanied by a fee paying adult.

**All applications will be verified before a F.A.C.S card is issued.**

**The Authority reserves the right to terminate membership should any breach of the F.A.C.S Scheme conditions occur, or should reasonable grounds be given by the facility Manager.**

**The Authority reserves the right to alter the conditions of use at any time.**
