Waste	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First revision of Joint Municipal Waste Management Strategy, now 'a Plan for Waste Management', agreed by all Surrey authorities at the end 2010 • New opportunities for improved joint working agreed by Surrey Chief Executives and Surrey First following advice and a report from AEA • Partnership Projects Programme being implemented using pooled money and developing projects of value to Partners • Joint training, development, seminars, workshops and information gathering tours, to increase the capacity of the Partnership's Members and Officers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Savings identified from optimal joint working: £2m in first 2 years, further £17m in next 5 years, further £41m up to 2021 • Initial savings spinning-out of partnership projects starting to materialise, e.g. £200,000 annual savings in garden waste removal and processing costs 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2011 Annual Review of actions in 'a Plan for Waste Management', and of the principles and objectives in the MoU due to be considered in June, together with proposals for targeted intervention in areas of underperformance • Improved Joint Working Action Plans due to be considered in July, setting-out the steps and necessary rewards to move towards a 70% recycling rate (World Class Waste Management) • Recycling Mixed Plastics report and proposals for Surrey due to be considered this summer • Bring Sites report and proposals for Surrey collection authorities due to be considered this summer • Further training, development, seminars and an open day will be put in place, especially for any Members new to waste management
