### New for 2009

Playscheme and Play Plus do not have off site trips this year however as you will see from their activity programme (page 8) they now have a very varied onsite programme with such visitors as the Mad Scientist courtesy of P&G sponsorship, Spider Mountain, Cub Carting and much more with the usual arts, crafts, games, sports and play.

Hi, my name is Emma Parnell and I'm the new Activity Co-ordinator (Sports and Play) for Runnymede Borough Council. I will be delivering FREE open access play sessions in parks, open spaces and community venues across the Borough during the summer holidays for children aged 5-13 to take part in.



'ROAR' (Runnymede Open Access Recreation) is an open access scheme which means children are free to come and go as they please and no bookings are required.

During 'ROAR' sessions there will be no formal supervision of your child by the staff of Runnymede Borough Council. Staff are there to organise the activity only. Therefore children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by someone aged 13 or above (i.e. an older sibling or parent/guardian) who is responsible for them. The staff will provide opportunities for children to be challenged and have fun.

Exact dates, times and locations to be confirmed, information will be publicised on the Runnymede Borough Council Website, through schools and on Council notice boards, leisure centres and other community venues. So watch this space!

### **ADDLESTONE (EY349822)\***

Jubilee High School, School Lane, Addlestone, Surrey, KT15 1TE

(Playscheme 40 spaces, Play Plus 48 spaces)

This is one of our biggest sites and caters for in excess of 80 children per day. This site received an OFSTED inspection in 2007 and received the grade of "GOOD", meaning the provision is STRONG.

### **CHERTSEY (EY346426)**

St Anne's School, Free Prae Road, Chertsey, Surrey, KT16 8ET

(Playscheme spaces 40, Play Plus 40 spaces)

We have the use of extensive grounds, access to two classrooms, school hall, and music room. The school is also surrounded by a very secure perimeter fence. Disabled toilet facilities and ramped access are available. This site received an OFSTED inspection in 2007 and received the grade of "GOOD", meaning the provision is STRONG.

### **EGHAM (Y348322)\***

Magna Carta School (St Pauls Road Entrance), Thorpe Road, Egham, Surrey, TW20 3HJ

(Playscheme 40 spaces, Play Plus 40 spaces)

This is one of the larger sites and can cater for 80 children daily. Children will benefit from the use of the art room (access via staircase), music room, sports hall all on ground floor and extensive playing fields. Disabled toilet facilities are available. This site received an OFSTED inspection in 2007 and received the grade of "GOOD", meaning the provision is STRONG.

### **OTTERS Shaw (160653)**

(Pre-School & Scout Hut) Memorial Fields, Foxhills Road, Ottershaw, Surrey, KT16 0NQ

(Playscheme 28 spaces, Play Plus 32 spaces)

Farthings Nursery and Scout and Guide Hut are our Ottershaw hosts again for 2009. This site also received an OFSTED inspection in 2006 and received the grade of "GOOD", meaning the provision is STRONG. This sites suits the outdoor type, children enjoy regular trips to the park, play area and the woods for a variety of adventures. Disabled toilet facilities are available. Both buildings have a ramped access.

## SURREY YOUTH GAMES 7 - 15 YRS

### Various Venues

The Surrey Youth Games are the largest annual youth sports festival in Surrey. It is an event that provides many young people, aged 7-15, with some experience of a competitive, countywide sporting event.

The games are essentially a mini-Olympic event where each of the eleven Boroughs in Surrey compete against each other in a variety of sports. See page 18 for sports.

# Runnymede Borough Council

## Terms & Conditions

### 1. POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Runnymede Borough Council is fully registered with OFSTED and abides by the 1989 Children Act and the Children Act 2004. Part of these requirements is keeping an extensive collection of relevant policy and procedures for our activities. Any adult requesting to see these can view them onsite or at the Civic Offices. The policies and procedures include our Safeguarding Children Policy which operates under the Surrey Safeguarding Children's Board guidelines. All staff have awareness and training in Child Protection and shall always act within the best interests of the child/children in our care.

### 2. SECURITY AND SAFETY

Your child's security and safety is a high priority and comes first during all Runnymede Leisure Service's activities. High standards are required by legislation such as the Children's Act and therefore all organisation and administration has been structured to comply with this.

- ALL children under 11 years old must be signed in and signed out by a responsible adult aged 18+.
- On arrival for an activity, all participants over 11 years old must be registered and report to the organiser.
- We have a password system for added security for all under 11 participants. When you fill in your booking form please insert a password between 4 & 8 characters and/or letters. This password will then have to be given to us by the responsible named adult aged 18+ picking your child up before they will be allowed to leave. Choose carefully, you don't want to forget it! For obvious reasons we ask that you do not tell your child this password and we will not be able to accept this password if given to us by your child when leaving.
- Participants are responsible for their own belongings and should avoid bringing valuables.
- Participants must wear suitable and appropriate clothing before taking part in any activity.

### 3. ACTIVITIES AND CANCELLATIONS

All activities may be subject to change and amendment. Runnymede Borough Council reserves the right to change any activity due to unforeseen circumstances. Each activity has a minimum and maximum booking restriction and Runnymede Borough Council reserve the right to cancel an activity if the participation figures are insufficient for an effective session to proceed. In the event of major changes, you will be notified.

### 4. REFUNDS

No refunds will be issued for cancellation of places, failure to attend booked activities or if your child is excluded due to sickness or behavioural issues. This is unless you have taken out the optional insurance at the time of booking and are covered by its terms and conditions.

### 5. BEHAVIOUR POLICY

All children will be expected to behave in an appropriate manner towards staff, coaches, property, equipment and other children. Any child behaving unacceptably will receive a formal warning. If any child receives three such warnings, Runnymede Borough Council reserve the right to exclude them from an activity and/or ban the child from attending further activities and NO refunds will be issued, even if the optional insurance has been taken out.

A scheme supervisor may in appropriate cases require a child to take a day out of the activity or the removal of a child from the activity on site or an off site trip. Unacceptable behaviour includes swearing, smoking, consuming alcohol, deliberately endangering self or others, bullying or disrupting activity sessions. This also includes behaviour that the supervisors feel is inappropriate and/or adversely affects the enjoyment of the activity by other participants.

### 6. STAFFING & SUPERVISION

Our activities work on a ratio of 1:7 for Playscheme, 1:8 for Play Plus and 1:10 for SPLASH. All activities are fully supervised by our staff, who will be clearly identified by their uniform t-shirts & I.D. Badges. All staff are subject to an enhanced CRB (Criminal Records Bureau) check and receive training prior to the commencement of the activities.

### 7. SPECIAL NEEDS - PLEASE BOOK EARLY SO STAFFING CAN BE ARRANGED.

We try wherever possible to cater for all individual needs, but this is dependent on the facilities available at each site and the additional supervision required. We endeavour where possible to provide staff to support children who may need a little extra help to participate fully in the activities. If your child has special needs and could benefit from this service then please tick the appropriate box on the booking form and someone will be in touch to discuss this further. Every effort will be made to cater for your child's needs but this is subject to staff qualifications and availability. **Please note, we cannot provide one to one care for your child.** If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to ring the Leisure department on 01932 425693.

### 8. INSURANCE

- All insurance claims must be made in writing, sent to the Runnymede Borough Council's Insurance Officer and should include all supporting documents.
- All insurance claims are subject to a £15 excess and will be dealt with by Zurich Municipal on behalf of Runnymede Borough Council.

## 9. LUNCH TIMES AND HEALTHY EATING

### **Playschemes, Athletics courses and Multi Sports weeks -**

All participants must be provided with a packed lunch and plenty of drinks for the entire day, everyday.

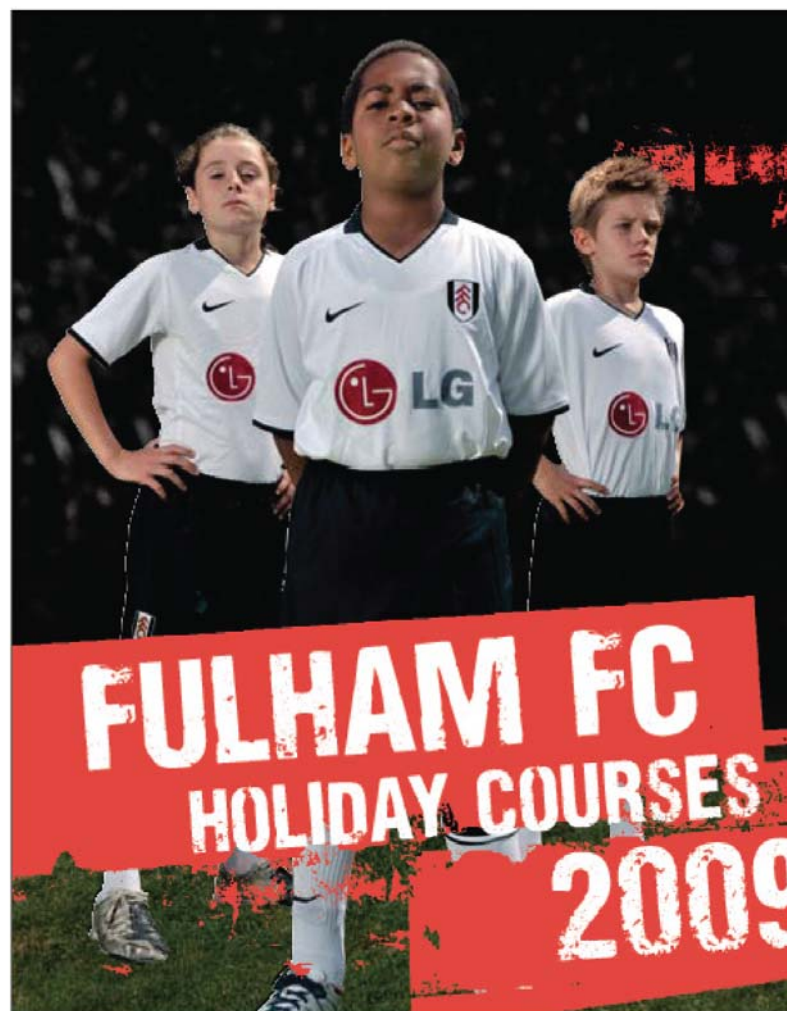
