

ADDLESTONE LEISURE CENTRE SCORES WITH NEW GOALPOSTS FROM FOOTBALL FOUNDATION

Following a successful bid, the Football Foundation has awarded Addlestone Leisure Centre a £1,830 grant to replace its football goalposts. The leisure centre applied for funding through the Football Foundation's Goalpost Safety Scheme.

Funded by the Premier League, the Football Association (FA), Sport England and the Government, the Football Foundation is dedicated to revitalising the grass roots of the game, constructing modern football facilities, developing football as a force for social cohesion and as a vehicle for education in communities.
