<p>The minutes of the last meeting were agreed. A P went through each item and fully explained it to the members of the group.</p> <p>Discussion was raised again about Sharon's Bike Project by AP and it was suggested that they can now have the bid as it was not the fault of the bid applicants that there had been a change in the rules mid decision making, the project is worth while and the risk assessment are all fine as is the security.</p>	
<p>Runnymede Youth Festival:</p> <p>Alan Bostock confirmed that he would be happy to take photo's of the event and it was pointed out about the coloured wrist bands that will be used by participants of the event to reflect if they had consent for photo's / filming of them to be done. Photo's would be looked at after the event and then deletion of those without permission to take place. Examples were also shown of the current web page with the use of the tasters.</p> <p>Since this meeting Natalie has spoken to the web team and it now seems possible to have an independent website from RBC which will not have to comply with so much corporate regulation. Natalie to investigate further and update at next meeting.</p>													
<p>LSP: (Local Strategy Partnership) AP updated explained to the group what the LSP is about, who is represented and issues covered including: Diplomas - AP felt that this was not a good idea for 14 year olds to take part in a scheme that they might not find useful at the end of their education as it is often the case that you don't know what you want to do when you leave, especially at the age of 14. Football Tournament - to be held at Egham Leisure Centre, organized by Cllr Kusneratis A-Level citizenship - to be linked with Strodes College and include involvement with a community project. Cllr John Furey would organise work experience within RBC for participants. Cllr John Furey also agreed to meet with AP to discuss funding opportunities for projects.</p>													
<p>YOF / YCF Update: Handouts were passed out to everyone explaining changes that had taken place for the next round of funding. It was agreed that the committee would meet during school holiday's possibly at an earlier time and also that the days should be alternated between the last Wednesday and Friday of the month. <p>AOB: Natalie confirmed that a Splash member of staff is also and Event co-ordinator and she would be consulted and invited along to future meetings to offer support and or guidance.</p> <p>Natalie raised a query that had arisen from Zareena Linney who is involved with the babylink project based in Addlestone that received funding from the YOF. The original group has now closed and they would like to continue running with a new group.
