Cardboard	Cardboard and mixed paper collected at bring sites is initially taken to a waste transfer station in Guildford where it is bulked up and sent on where it is manufactured back into paper/cardboard products such as hand towels
Tetra Pack	The carton recycling banks in Runnymede are part of a national scheme recently introduced by carton manufacturers. Cartons are bulked-up at regional 'hubs' and then transported to paper mills in Northern Europe, primarily the Orebro Mill in Sweden. There are no mills in the UK at present that can recycle the cartons. The recovered fibres are used for making new paper products, including paper bags, envelopes and plasterboard liners.
