Runnymede Infrastructure Schedules 2015-2030

- 1.1 The Runnymede Infrastructure Schedules set out the information contained in the Infrastructure Delivery Plan and its Addendum in 5 year phases. The schedules update those contained in the IDP and the Addendum where project details have either changed or been updated and this reflects the 'living' document referred to in the IDP. The schedules do not however change the infrastructure baseline or the forecast demand scenarios outlined in the Infrastructure Needs Assessment (INA) and the IDP & Addendum and neither do they change project timing or costs where these have been indicated previously. However, the schedules are now more aligned to Local Plan development requirements, plan period, phasing requirements and spatial distribution.
- 1.2 The IDP considered forecasts for infrastructure demand as a result of three possible Local Plan housing requirements based on Spatial Strategy options SS3 (380dpa), SS5 (466dpa) and SS6 (535dpa) and over the period 2015/16-2034/35. The IDP split the period for forecast infrastructure demands into 5 year phases as 2015/16-2019/20, 2020/21-2024/25, 2025/26–2029/30 and 2030/31-2034/35. As such, it is possible to align the schedules and demand forecasts to the Local Plan period 2015-2030 by disregarding demand requirements in the period 2030/31-2034/35.
- 1.3 In terms of the Spatial Strategy options tested in the IDP, the draft Local Plan (as modified) proposes to meet Runnymede's OAN with a housing requirement of 498dpa. This roughly corresponds to the average between options SS5 and SS6 at 500dpa and therefore it is possible to extrapolate forecast demands into schedules on this basis to align with the Local Plan requirement.
- 1.4 Further, where only generic infrastructure projects have been identified the cost of these is also proportional in each 5 year period based on the expected trajectory of housing delivery in that 5 year period as set out within the Draft Local Plan (as modified). As such, the level of development expected to come forward in each 5 year phase is anticipated as follows:

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2015/16 - 2019/20 - 2,720 dwellings (36%)
2020/21- 2024/25 - 2,935 dwellings (39%)
2025/26 - 2029/30 - 1,825 dwellings (25%)
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1.5 For transparency, Appendix A sets out how certain generic infrastructure costs set out in the IDP have been calculated in each 5 year phase. The schedules take account of both borough wide and site level projects.
