Statement of Inspection Procedure

The Runnymede Pitch and Plot Allocation Scheme for Gypsies, Travellers and Travelling Showpeople Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) provides guidance to support the implementation of Policy SL22 of the adopted Runnymede 2030 Local Plan which is concerned with meeting the accommodation needs of Gypsies, Travellers and Travelling Showpeople (referred to hereafter as Travellers). Specifically, it seeks to provide further clarity on how a discreet part of the policy on page 110 of the Local Plan, which is concerned with the provision of new pitches and plots on sites allocated through the Local Plan, should be applied.

Runnymede Borough Council formally adopted the SPD on 28 May 2025, with an implementation date of 9 June 2025.
