Application for the re-designation of the Ottershaw Neighbourhood Forum

An application has been received by Runnymede Borough Council for the re-designation of the Ottershaw Neighbourhood Forum. This is now the subject of public consultation.

On 14th October 2020 members of Runnymede Borough Council Planning Committee resolved to designate The Ottershaw Neighbourhood Forum. This designation lasts for five years and expires on the 14th October 2025.

If the forum is re-designated no other organisation or body may be designated for that neighbourhood area until the designation expires or is withdrawn.
