
Public Path Diversion Order Town And Country Planning Act 1990, Section 257 Runnymede Borough Council Public Footpath 53 (Egham) Public Path Diversion Order 2024

This Order is made by Runnymede Borough Council under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely: the development of housing for which planning permission has been granted (RU.22/0682).

BY THIS ORDER:-

- 1 THE footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule of this Order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted
- There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Surrey County
 Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said
 footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black
 dashes on the attached map ("Drawing No. 3/1/88/H44A").
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the confirmation of this Order.
- 4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

SCHEDULE PART 1

Description of site of existing path or way

Footpath 53 (Egham) from Point D (Grid Reference 501697 168820) in a southerly turning to south westerly direction for 157 metres past point B to Point E (Grid Reference 501653 168685) as shown on Drawing No. 3/1/88/H44A

PART 2 Description of site of alternative highway

Footpath 53 (Egham) from Point D (Grid Reference 501697 168820) in a westerly turning to generally southerly direction for 200 metres via Point C to Point E (Grid Reference 501653 168685) as shown on Drawing No. 3/1/88/H44A. The footpath to have a width of 2 metres throughout.
