Screening Determination Notice under Regulation 11

Regulation 11 of the Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004 requires Runnymede Borough Council to determine whether the Virginia Water Neighbourhood Development Plan is likely to have significant environmental effects.

On 14 July 2025, Runnymede Borough Council determined after consultation with Natural England, the Environment Agency and English Heritage that the Virginia Water Neighbourhood Development Plan is not likely to have significant environmental effects and, therefore, a Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) is not required.
