I have recently read all the documents available online and broadly support the proposals contained in the various papers.

There are some matters which I feel have not been considered in enough detail which affect many local residents.

I have lived in [REDACTED] for over 40 years and am increasingly concerned about the volume and high speed of vehicles using this narrow road with poor sight lines as a

cut through between Trumps Green Road and Wellington Avenue. There is only a poorly maintained footpath on one side of the road and the hedges are frequently overgrown forcing pedestrians in certain sections to walk in the road. This is a particular risk for parents taking young children to and from Trumps Green School. Traffic calming measures and speed restrictions are urgently required to ensure the safety of all pedestrians.

Additionally there are no controlled crossing points to access King George V Playing Fields from Crown Road or Trumps Green Road.

There is a childrens playground with an entrance from Crown Road and it is extremely dangerous for children and parents to cross the road here with such poor visibility in both directions.

[REDACTED] Knowle Hill Tennis Club and with no dedicated parking on site many players have to park in Oak Tree Close when visiting the Club. It is then necessary to cross Trumps Green Road to get to the entrance to the courts avoiding fast moving traffic with many drivers exceeding the current speed limit.

We have over 200 members including a large number of juniors and it is a thriving community asset.

I believe there is a clear case for reducing the speed limit on Trumps Green Road.

I hope these representations will receive serious attention.
